The purpose of this award is to recognize those with extraordinary, consistent contributions and/or distinguished service to NAIDC.

REQUIREMENTS FOR NOMINATION:

Nominee must have served the North American Intercollegiate Dairy Challenge with unusual distinction.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Nominees will be selected by the NAIDC Board of Directors. The number of recipients, the frequency of providing this award, and where to present the award are at the discretion of the NAIDC Board of Directors.

NATURE OF THE AWARD:

A perpetual listing will be established and maintained on the Dairy Challenge web site. A personalized plaque will be presented to each recipient.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION ON NOMINEE:

The principal nominator shall send supporting materials to info@dairychallenge.org to include:

- a. A short summary statement (no more than one page) documenting accomplishments and outlining major contributions to Dairy Challenge and the dairy industry.
- b. At least 1 letter of support
