Internship Details:

Requirements: Sophomore status or higher in good standing and on track to the complete an agricultural-related B.S. degree

Employment: Student will be an employee of Vita Plus.

Compensation: Part-time status, \$15/hour, expect 40-50 hours per week during the summer. Benefits not included.

Location & travel: Most of travel will be within southwest Wisconsin, northern Illinois and eastern Iowa.

This may include some overnights. All travel expenses will be reimbursed.

Intern Project: Evaluating dietary factors and their relationship to milk fat production and milk fatty acid profiles

Hypothesis: Evaluation of dietary fractions and milk fatty acid profiles will provide key markers that will aid in developing TMR

NIR equations to assess on-farm milk fat production.

Specific Aims: 1. Evaluate the relationship between dietary components, milk fat acid profiles and milk fat production.

2. Develop NIR equations for TMR samples that may aid help determine on-farm milk fat production.

Experience Includes:

- Job shadow and collaborate in a team environment doing on-farm nutrition and consulting with Vita Plus nutritionists
- Work in collaboration with dairy technical specialists in a lab setting and develop new technologies for on-farm usage
- Participate in team meetings and attend Vita Plus sponsored regional meetings
