- Deadline for entries: February 19, 2016
- Tips for completing the form
- Student Information Forms due March 6
- Housing due March 6 complete details will come with Confirmation letter after Feb 19
 - Dairy Challenge pays for lodging for all participating students.
 Coaches pay for their own lodging.

Dairy Challenge Academy – Eligibility

Eligible Students

- Sophomores, juniors, and seniors from 4-year dairy programs, and undergraduates from community colleges and technical schools
- Student at a North American educational institution that offers classes with an emphasis in dairy production
- Enrolled in a program of study to meet requirements for a bachelor's degree, or be enrolled in a dairy/animal degree or certificate granting program and have completed one year of course work
- A contestant may only participate/compete in a total of two (2) regional contests, two (2) Dairy
 Challenge Academies and one (1) National Dairy Challenge Contest.

Not Eligible for Academy

- Students enrolled in graduate or professional studies programs
- Student who has competed in NAIDC national contest, or has been an employee or paid consultant of any agricultural organization or service for which his/her duties included on-farm dairy consulting (excluding internships)

Maximum of 200 Academy participants

- May register up to 6 students per school.
- Additional students may be registered in case fewer than 200 students register.



Dairy Challenge Academy - Changes

- More "professional" presentations
 - Academy groups will create a brief PowerPoint presentation rather than writing on flip charts as previous
- Consideration of experience levels
 - There was considerable diversity of dairy analysis experience among the 2015
 Academy participants, and some felt this hindered learning/challenge.
 - We will attempt to sort more experienced and inexperienced students into separate groups, so groups can work at a pace geared to their learning level.
 Establishment of Academy groups will be guided by new questions on student information form. This change is NOT to be publicized to students this is only for awareness by Academy advisors and organizers, and it is designed to help each participant have an optimal learning experience.



2016 National Contest

- <u>Number of teams:</u> optimum 32; maximum of 36 with ranking based on date and time of registration and number of years having participated in regional and national dairy challenges during past 10 years
- <u>Computer</u> use and hardware/software requirements read carefully the computer specifications provided on web page; Each school is asked to bring 2 computers and they will not have to check them in; a computer will be provided with DHI software and herd data; none of the computers will have to be turned in on Thursday pm
- <u>Photos</u> will be allowed using the cameras approved/provided by the Contest.
 Schools with cameras are asked to bring them.
- <u>Cell phone usage</u> will **NOT** be permitted on the farm
- Use of the <u>internet</u> is allowed in preparing presentations
- No restrictions on using a repository for information (e.g. Dropbox) or use of additional printed resources
- Materials from past contests available for your review with your students on the web site under Member Log in. Password is "coach"
