

Dress Code Reminder for Dairy Challenge

Keep in mind that you may be meeting with your perspective employer at any point in time during the Dairy Challenge.

Thursday afternoon: Barn clothes-warm with appropriate footwear for visiting an operating dairy barn. The farms are freestall operations and you will be wandering around for about 2 hours.

Thursday evening/Friday morning: Please change into something clean, such as jeans and tee-shirt or sweatshirt. You will be in a hotel room all afternoon. There is no need to bring the odors and any other residues from the farm that you visited with you to the hotel room that you are working on your presentation in.

Friday afternoon or Saturday morning when you are presenting and visiting our Career Fair: Business formal for your presentation and visit to the sponsor booths. This essentially means shirt, tie, dress pants and dress shoes for gentlemen and professional equivalent for ladies-dress like you are going to a first job interview for a job that you really want. No sweatshirts, no hats.

Friday evening: Casual but nice. Your evening session is at Sunnyside Farm and includes a guest speaker and opportunity to sit and visit with potential employers. Plan to dress to stay warm as dinner is in the shop at the farm.

Saturday morning if you are not presenting: You may wear what you are traveling home in, but don't look unkempt. Keep in mind that you may be meeting with your perspective employer at any point in time during the Dairy Challenge.
