Please follow the link provided below to register your team for this year's event. Please fill out this form and have it submitted by <u>Friday, March 22 at 5:00 PM</u>. You will be prompted to enter the names of all of your team members (up to 4). In addition, you will indicate the school you are representing, along with the names of your 3 to 4 person team. We ask that <u>ALL</u> team members submit their own registration. If you indicated that you do not have a team, but would still like to participate, please indicate that again on the registration page and you will be assigned to a team). Remember that you will be provided with a hotel room, courtesy of Merck Animal Health, for Thursday night (April 4th). Those of you who plan to stay in Columbus for the remainder of the Symposium are responsible for booking your own rooms for any additional nights.

On the Wednesday before the contest (April 3), farm records will be emailed to all participants. We encourage you all to look over them before Friday's farm visit. Based on student feedback from previous contests, in order to optimize your time on the contest day, we

also suggest and encourage your team to create a basic PowerPoint shell for your presentation

before you arrive.
