## **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES**

The following are areas where assistance is needed. If you have a volunteer duty preference, please indicate as such on the volunteer form and every opportunity will be made to assign you those responsibilities.

- Mentors: We need volunteers on Thursday Evening thru the farm visit on Friday morning to Mentor the student groups and to work with them on the host farms. You will work with your group on Thursday evening as they start to look through information and prepare for the farm tour. You will then escort this group of students while on the farm tour on Friday morning. It is critical all volunteers who do want to sign up for this new duty are available all of Thursday evening thru lunch on Friday. We will need at least 12 mentors available. Based on mentor comments in recent years, we are seeking one mentor per team to stay throughout the entire event (through Saturday presentation) to allow for even more interaction with your team and to provide cohesiveness for the team. They will assist the team by being in the prep room on Saturday, to be their team guide to the presentation, be present during the presentation and then be their guide to debriefing.
  - Please indicate your plans on the volunteer registration form.
- Farm Volunteers: We need people on Friday morning to help get the students on buses and keep them moving on the host farms.
- Support Help: Individuals are needed for Friday afternoon to assist teams in getting support from IT, questions answered, and to assist with farm manager meetings.
- Room Monitors and Time-Keepers: We need 3-6 room monitors and 3-6 time keepers for Saturday's presentations.
   These volunteers are needed to share the coverage of the 3-6 presentation rooms from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturday.
- Debrief Team: We need 3 individuals to visit with teams following their presentation for 10 minute debriefing sessions on their experience.
