Airport Information for Green Bay, Wisconsin

Green Bay Austin Straubel International Airport (GRB): 8 miles

Appleton International Airport (ATW): 35 miles southwest of Green Bay

General Mitchell International Airport (MKE): 129 miles, 2 hours south of Green Bay

Parking in Green Bay: Hyatt hotel parking is \$10.00 per night for overnight guests. Additional parking can be found in the attached Main Street parking garage for day guests .85 cents per hour from 6am to 6pm Monday to Friday. You can park overnight but are only charged from 6:00am to 6:00pm. Parking in the attached Main Street garage is free on Saturday and Sunday. Parking for Hampton guests is free in their lot.
