DAIRY CHALLENGE VET

Dairy Challenge Vet is a competition designed to assess students' knowledge of current recommended dairy practices and principles of dairy farm management. It provides students with the opportunity to evaluate management practices of a host dairy and present their findings in front of a panel of representatives from the dairy industry. Students are grouped in teams of three to four individuals. Teams receive farm records and spend two hours at the host farm, evaluating all aspects of the operation, including reproduction, housing, milking procedures, nutrition, etc. Then teams prepare a 15-minute presentation and present in front of a panel of judges. 10 minutes are allotted for questions from the judges' panel after each presentation.
