MEAL TICKETS: Meals are a great opportunity to interact with students and other volunteers. However, a significant portion of our sponsorship dollars go toward event meals. New this year we are asking volunteers to purchase meal tickets by day so sponsorship dollars can be used to support student involvement. Tickets can be purchased in advance when registering.

SPONSOR CAREER AND INNOVATION FAIR: On Friday you are invited to set up a booth in our Career and Innovation Fair at the KI Convention Center. Booths will be open between 8:30 am and 3:00 pm. Indicate your desire to reserve a booth using the online registration form. There is no charge for the space. Electricity will be available, but you will need to supply your own electrical cords. All sponsors are encouraged to reserve a space to interact with students and University coaches and to view student presentations on Friday. Remember because of the number of teams, presentations will be going simultaneously. This is a terrific opportunity to visit with each participant at the event, particularly if your company is seeking interns or job recruits.

MENTORS: We are seeking a large number of volunteers to serve as Team Mentors. This is an important role as Mentors work side by side with the student teams to guide them through the farm analysis process. With enough volunteers, we hope to assign 1 mentor to each team and have a pool of Roaming Mentors.

## Please note:

- <u>Team Mentors</u> must be available starting with the Mentor Meeting at 4:00 PM Wednesday until your team presents on Friday. Staying for the entire event (through presentations on Friday) allows for more interaction with your team and provides cohesiveness for the team. Mentors will review data with students Wednesday evening, tour the dairy on Thursday morning, offer guidance while assembling their presentation on Thursday afternoon, oversee team prep on Friday, direct your team to their presentation room on Friday, be present during the presentation, and be their guide to debriefing.
- If you are interested in serving as a Mentor but not able to commit through Friday, we suggest signing up as a Roaming Mentor or other volunteer role.
- Mentors are asked to bring a camera or camera-capable phone to take pictures for their groups and be willing/able to download the pictures.

- Mentors should be committed to the event and willing to work with students in a positive and supportive manner, encouraging participation and guiding them in their dairy assessment.

  - A Respectful Attitude
  - o Eagerness to Invest in Others
  - Ability to Give Honest & Direct Feedback
  - Reflective Listening & Empathy

This is a great recruiting opportunity to get to know the students in a fun, relaxed, informal setting. INDUSTRY PANEL: On Friday February 9 we will feature alumni/industry panels (one in the morning, one in the afternoon). These panels are your opportunity to share your career insights. Alumni of Dairy Challenge are especially encouraged to sign up to serve on these panels.
